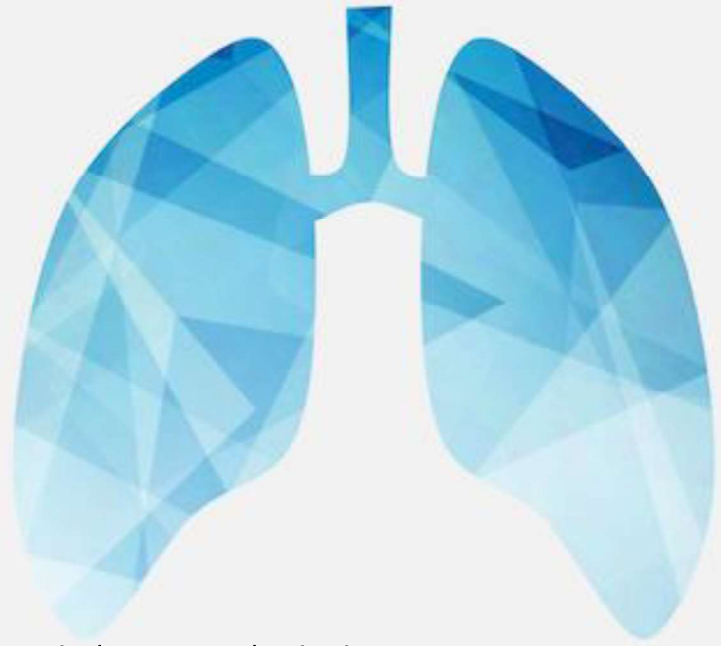


## DO YOU HAVE COPD?



Our practice is participating in a research study (MAGNIFY) which aims to support treatment use in patients with COPD through the use of a novel device. This device can be offered to suitable patients for 12 months, for use with the Ultibro® inhaler. It monitors inhalations and sends reminders to the user's smartphone and reminds them to take their daily dose. It will also allow our healthcare professionals to monitor patients' inhaler use and provide more personalised support.

As part of this research, non-identifiable information about all our patients with COPD can be shared with the MAGNIFY research team. **The researchers do not receive any data that would identify our patients personally.** No personal details (e.g. names, addresses) will be shared. The researchers will evaluate the impact of the adherence device on clinical outcomes such as COPD exacerbations.

**If you do not want your anonymised data to be shared for research purposes, you can withdraw from sharing your information at any time.** This will not affect the care you receive in any way. Only your GP surgery will know whether you choose to opt out or not. Please speak with a member of the reception team if you would like to opt out.

The research study is managed by the Observational and Pragmatic Research Institute (OPRI) and funded by Novartis AG. The devices have been provided by Propeller Health Technologies. The study has been approved by the Health Research Authority and Derby Research Ethics Committee.
